Our CGE program has led the way for our Society for decades. With the recent developments in technology and terminology the Board and Officers thought it was paramount to update our Study Guide and Exam. The need to stay prestigious and professional in this field is imperative to our Society. With this in mind, we hired five professional consultants to examine the Study Guide and Exam material. This project, which started in the fall of 2022, is not just an errata page to the current Study Guide, it has turned into a complete overhaul of the information. We are making significant changes, omissions, and additions. So much so that it will no longer be called a "Study Guide" and will now be known as the "ASGE Handbook." Our intention is that the Study Guide overhaul with all its revisions will be completed this fall so that we can begin the overhaul of the Exam by years end. Careful consideration is being made on how to distribute this new format to our current and future members. Look for more information on this in the future.

This past year, ASGE signed our first joint response letter to the DOE, aligning our Society along with other associations in the rebuking of biased DOE rulings. Additionally, we continued our presence on the Building Energy Code and Standards Committee. Our presence has been welcomed, is valued and we have been called upon to respond with gas appliance manufacturers in mind.

ASGE was represented on Capitol Hill where gas utilization, appliances, and components were discussed with congress men and women who sit on the Energy and Commerce Sub Committee.

In summary, ASGE is doing so much more than a Technical Conference and what is mentioned above is still not everything. I want to remind everyone that as a member of our Society, you are a representative of any committee or employer roster. The main theme at the conference was the push from presenters or other members about getting involved in combating electrification, decarbonization, and the blatant agenda of the Presidential administration to phase out gas. 
