

ASGE is proud to announce that the newly minted "ASGE Handbook" content is complete and is going through final format editing and will be sent to printing early 2024!

You might be asking, When can I get a copy of the new ASGE Handbook? We will be selling them starting at the 2024 ASGE Technical Conference. If you have purchased the Study Guide previously, you will not have to pay full price for the new Handbook. Current and up to date CGEs will pay a discounted rate. Pricing will be marketed in one of the early newsletters in 2024.

The next question you are asking may be, Is the CGE Exam changing too? The quick answer is yes. The Exam will be re-engineered to follow the content of the new ASGE Handbook. The Exam project will begin right after the beginning of 2024.

The ASGE Handbook will be put out into circulation starting June 2024. The intent is for the new Handbook to be published for one year before the new Exam is administered. So, the new CGE Exam will be given starting June 2025.
